## BATTERY

BRP recommends keeping your Vibe system under surveillance while charging the battery.

### ⚠ WARNING

BRP recommends keeping your focus on the road at all times. Use your Vibe Communication System only when conditions are safe.

### ⚠ CAUTION

Prolonged exposure to loud music can damage hearing; BRP recommends a 10 min. break for every 45 min. of listening.
